



CLASS OF GROUND: Aerodrome licensed for light landplanes only.

PROPRIETORS: The Gympie Agricultural, Mining and Pastoral Society. Secretary, Mr. E.J. Healy.

POSITION: On showground, $1\frac{1}{2}$ miles SW of Gympie.

Lat: $26^{\circ} 12' S$; Long: $152^{\circ} 39' E$.

MAGNETIC VARIATION: $9^{\circ} E$. approx.

LANDMARKS: Showground buildings south-west of Gympie.

Mary River $\frac{1}{2}$ mile north.

MARKINGS: Wind indicator.

SURFACE: Hard, smooth surface falling towards the northern end.
Should be suitable in all weathers.

DIMENSIONS: E-W: 480 yards; N-S: 410 yards.

HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 290 feet.

APPROACHES: North - felled timber, telephone and power lines.

East - felled timber, tall trees further back. South - sheds and timber. West - houses, scattered tall timber and telephone line.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Undulating and timbered with several clear patches.

PETROL, OIL & WORKSHOPS: Gympie.

WATER SUPPLY: At showground building.

HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.

TELEPHONE: Jockey Club Hotel, near corner of ground.

TELEGRAPH: Gympie.

NEAREST TOWN & RAILWAY STATION: Gympie.

CHARGES: Aero Club machines free; others 2/6d. per landing.

REMARKS: Stripmap No.61. Pilots without knowledge of ground should not land in N or S direction.
