


LICENSED AERODROME, "B" CLASS



LATITUDE:  $34^{\circ}31'$  S. LONGITUDE:  $144^{\circ}51'$  E. MAG. VAR:  $8^{\circ}$  E. approx.

ALTITUDE: 300 feet approx.

POSITION: Approx.  $1\frac{1}{2}$  miles south of town of Hay.

RELEVANT AVIATION MAPS: Mercator Sheet J.8. Stripmaps Nos. 9, 30 and 31.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Open level country with scattered trees. Suitable for forced landings.

LANDMARKS: Day: Town of Hay approx.  $1\frac{1}{2}$  miles north. Main road E of aerodrome. Bridge over Murrumbidgee River  $\frac{3}{4}$  mile NE.

Night: Nil.

APPROACHES: W and S - clear; N - a few scattered trees along Bungah Creek; E - scattered trees 20' to 30' high E of road.

MARKINGS: White circle, boundary marks and wind indicator.

LIGHTING: Nil.

DIMENSIONS: N-S, 660 yards; E-W, 660 yards.

SURFACE: Good.

TOWN & RAILWAY STATION: Hay,  $1\frac{1}{2}$  miles N.

TELEPHONE: At Hay.

HANGARS: Nil.

REPAIRS & REFUELLING: At Hay.

WATER: At water channel NW.

PROPRIETORS: Hay Municipal Council.

CHARGES: Nil at present.

SPECIAL REMARKS: "B" Class in dry weather only. Surface liable to be soft in wet weather.
