




LICENSED AERODROME, "C" CLASS



LATITUDE: 20° 49' S; LONGITUDE: 144° 13' E; MAG. VAR: 6° E. app.
ALTITUDE: About 1,000 feet.
POSITION: About 2 miles NNE of Hughenden.
RELEVANT AVIATION MAP: Mercator Sheet F.8.
SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Timbered. Open downs to S & W of Hughenden.
LANDMARKS: Hughenden township on bank of Flinders River.
APPROACHES: North and West - over scattered timber. South - over timber. East - over tel. line 12 ft. high.
MARKINGS: White circle, wind indicator and boundary marks.
DIMENSIONS: N-S, 600 yards. WNW-ESE, 700 yards.
SURFACE: Clay pan with soft patches.

TOWN & RAILWAY STATION: Hughenden, 2 miles SSW.
TELEPHONE: Hughenden P.O.
HANGARS: Nil.
REPAIRS & REFUELLING: Hughenden.
WATER: At houses approx. 1 mile south.

PROPRIETORS: Flinders Shire Council, Hughenden, Qld.
CHARGES: Nil at present.

SPECIAL REMARKS: "C" class licence in favourable winds only.
The word "AIRPORT", in letters 6 feet high, and a directing arrow painted on both sides of the picture theatre roof, Hughenden. The ground probably unfit for use after rain.
