


EMERGENCY LANDING GROUND



LATITUDE: 27° 37' S; LONGITUDE: 152° 48' E; MAG. VAR: 8½° E app.
ALTITUDE: 50 feet approx.

POSITION: On racecourse immediately east of Bundamba - Redbank railway, about ¼ mile S of Bundamba Railway Station.

RELEVANT AVIATION MAPS: Mercator Sheet H.9. Stripmaps Nos. 2, 3, 49 and 61.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Hilly and timbered with some open spaces.
LANDMARKS: Brisbane-Ipswich railway ¼ mile north, railway and racecourse building immediately west.

APPROACHES: North - over 30 ft. tel. line, school and 30 ft. trees; south - over 50 ft. H.T. line and trees; east - open; west - over railway, 30 ft. tel. line and racecourse buildings.

MARKINGS: White cross and wind indicator.

DIMENSIONS: NW-SE, 550 yds. NE-SW, 550 yds; E-W, 440 yds.

SURFACE: Rough in parts. Falls gradually from centre to east boundary.

TOWN & RAILWAY STATION: Bundamba ¼ mile north.

TELEPHONE: Racecourse buildings or Bundamba Post Office.

HANGARS: Nil.

REPAIRS & REFUELLING: Garages nearby, or Ipswich 2 miles west.

WATER: On ground.

PROPRIETORS: Department of Civil Aviation, Melbourne.

CHARGES: Nil.
