

LICENSED AERODROME, "B" CLASS



LATITUDE: 20° 15' S; LONGITUDE: 140° 27' E; MAG. VAR: 5° E app.

ALTITUDE: 400 feet approx.

POSITION: $\frac{1}{2}$ mile south of homestead.

14 miles north-east of Quamby railway station.

RELEVANT AVIATION MAPS: Mercator Sheet F.7. Stripmap No.29.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Timbered, with open patches.

LANDMARKS: Telephone and fence along eastern boundary. Creek on western boundary.

APPROACHES: West - over creek and gullies. North - over light scattered timber. East - over tel. line 8' high along fence.

MARKINGS: White circle, wind indicator and boundary marks.

DIMENSIONS: 1,100 yards x 530 yards (see sketch).

SURFACE: Smooth and level.

TOWN & RAILWAY STATION: Quamby, 14 miles south-west.

TELEPHONE: At homestead.

HANGARS: Nil.

REPAIRS: Cloncurry.

REFUELLING: At homestead.

WATER: At homestead.

PROPRIETORS: Jessievale Pastoral Company, Quamby, via Cloncurry. (Chas. E. Stoddart, Esq., Manager).

CHARGES: Nil at present.
