



NOTICE TO AIRMEN

JUNI, N.G.



CLASS OF GROUND: Aerodrome licensed for single and light multi-engined types of landplanes.

PROPRIETORS: Messrs. Soltwedel & Gordon, Juni via Wau, N.G.

POSITION: In upper Waria River valley, on left bank of Waria River. Lat. $7^{\circ} 48' S$. Long. $147^{\circ} 11' E$.

MAGNETIC VARIATION: $5^{\circ} E$. approx.

LANDMARKS: Waria River, about $\frac{1}{2}$ mile to west.

MARKINGS: Wind indicator at south-west corner of runway; small white flags mark sides of runway.

SURFACE &c.: Level grassed surface, inclined to be soft and holding after heavy rain.

DIMENSIONS: Single strip approx. N.E. - S.W. 525 yds. x 75 yds.

HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 2,200 ft. approx.

APPROACHES: Clear; small rounded hill about $\frac{1}{4}$ mile to S.W.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Kunai covered river flats, swampy in places, suitable for forced landings.

PETROL AND OIL: Limited supply at Wau about 50 miles (by air) north-west.

WATER SUPPLY: Creeks nearby.

WORKSHOPS: Nil.

HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.

TELEGRAPH: Wau radio station, about 50 miles north-west.

NEAREST TOWN: Wau. Salamaua about 60 miles north.

REMARKS: Should only be used in the mornings as strong cross winds prevail during the afternoons.
