


## NOTICE TO AIRMEN

NO. 7/1929.

(REVISED AND REPRINTED 1935)

KALGOORLIE, W.A.

**CLASS OF GROUND:** Aerodrome suitable for all types of landplanes.  
**PROPRIETORS:** Commonwealth of Australia (Controller of Civil Aviation, Melbourne).

**POSITION:** Lat.  $30^{\circ} 45' S$ . Long.  $121^{\circ} 30' E$ . Situated between the Kalgoorlie and Boulder race-courses.

**MAGNETIC VARIATION:** About  $1\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} W$ .

**DISTINCTIVE FEATURES:** Kalgoorlie to North, Boulder to East and Boulder race-course about  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile South-east of Aerodrome.

**MARKINGS:** White circle and two wind indicators.

**DESCRIPTION:** Good surface; slightly undulating. Satisfactory in all weathers. Fenced all round.

**DIMENSIONS:** 1,000 yards in all directions.

**HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL:** About 1,240 feet.

**APPROACHES:** North, scattered mallee scrub; South, telephone line; East, few houses; West, few houses.

**SURROUNDING COUNTRY:** Forced landings could be effected in cleared patches.

**PETROL AND OIL:** On aerodrome.

**WATER SUPPLY:** On aerodrome.

**WORKSHOPS:** Kalgoorlie or Boulder.

**HANGAR ACCOMMODATION:** One (Western Mining Corporation).

**TELEPHONE:** On aerodrome.

**TELEGRAPH:** Boulder Post Office.

**NEAREST TOWN:** Boulder, about 2 miles East.

**NEAREST RAILWAY STATION:** Boulder

**CHARGES:** Nil.

**REMARKS:** Airway beacon and boundary lights available on application.
