




CLASS OF GROUND: Suitable for all types of landplanes.
 PROPRIETORS: Civil Aviation Board, Melbourne.
 POSITION: 1 mile NNE. of Post Office. Immediately east of river.
 Lat: $14^{\circ} 27' S$; Long: $132^{\circ} 16' E$.
 MAGNETIC VARIATION: $3\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} E$. approx.
 LANDMARKS: River on west and north; hospital north.
 MARKINGS: White circle, two wind indicators and corner marking.
 LIGHTING: Airway light adjacent to hospital. Color: white.
 Tilt: 2° . Revolutions, 6 r.p.m. Operated only on demand.
 SURFACE: Undulating, red soil. Fenced all round. One runway.
 DIMENSIONS: North-South 880 yards; East-West 640 yards.
 Runway, NW.-SE. 700 yards long by 33 yards wide.
 HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 330 feet approx.
 APPROACHES: Timber felled back to a depth of 10 chains from boundary fence in all directions.
 SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Heavy forest.
 PETROL & OIL: Knott's Store immediately north (or Katherine).
 WATER SUPPLY: River.
 WORKSHOPS: Katherine garages.
 HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Small private hangar.
 NEAREST TELEPHONE & TELEGRAPH: Katherine, 1 mile south by road.
 NEAREST TOWN & RAILWAY STATION: Katherine.
 REMARKS: In the Wet season planes must land on runway, for ant-beds grow rapidly on remainder of ground during the "wet".
 Stripmaps Nos. 1 and 7.
