


LATITUDE: 33° 22' S. LONGITUDE: 139° 29' E. MAG. VAR: 6° E. app.
 ALTITUDE: 100 feet approx.

POSITION: About 1 mile north-west of Kia Ora Homestead.

RELEVANT AVIATION MAP: Mercator sheet J.7.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Hilly and rough, covered with scrub. Un-
 suitable for forced landings.

LANDMARKS: Kia Ora Station Homestead and dams about 1 mile SE.
 APPROACHES: Immediate approaches are clear, with exception of
 small clumps of trees, to 15 ft. high, to north, north-east,
 south-east and south-west; otherwise trees to 15 ft. high
 in all directions.

MARKINGS: White semi-circle and wind indicator; boundary of
 ground is roughly marked with tins.

DIMENSIONS: N-S, 720 yards. E-W, 570 yards.

SURFACE: Good.

TOWN & RAILWAY STATION: Koorunga, approx. 45 miles south-west.

TELEPHONE: At homestead.

HANGARS: Nil.

REPAIRS & REFUELLING: Limited facilities at homestead.

WATER: At homestead.

PROPRIETOR: Mr. J.N. McBride, Kia Ora Station, via Koorunga, S.A.
 CHARGES: Nil at present.
