

CLASS OF GROUND: Emergency Landing Ground.
PROPRIETORS: Commonwealth of Australia (Controller of Civil Aviation, Melbourne).
POSITION: Lat. $18^{\circ}32'S$. Long. $127^{\circ}19'E$. To East of homestead and North of Mary River.
MAGNETIC VARIATION: About $2\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}E$.
DISTINCTIVE FEATURES: Clearing on eastern side of homestead.
MARKINGS: White cross and wind indicator on West boundary.
DESCRIPTION: One way ground. Soil, sandy loam; liable to be bumpy owing to sand drifts.
DIMENSIONS: 510 yards long by 150 yards wide. Runs approx. N.E. and S.W.
HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: About 800 feet.
APPROACHES: West, over homestead, yards and windmill. Elsewhere over low timber.
SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Generally timbered.
PETROL AND OIL: At homestead.
WATER SUPPLY: At homestead.
WORKSHOPS: Blacksmiths' tools at station.
HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.
TELEGRAPH: Hall's Creek Post Office, 55 miles East.
NEAREST TOWN: Wyndham, roughly 400 miles.
REMARKS: Relative Strip Map No. 56.
