


ALTITUDE: 1,500 feet approx.
POSITION: 1 mile north-east of Laverton township.
RELEVANT AVIATION MAPS: Mercator Sheet H-4.
SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Undulating, rocky and covered with 12 feet mulga scrub.
LANDMARKS: Dam to east, Rifle Range to west, and Racecourse Stand and creek adjacent to south boundary.
APPROACHES: Over 12 ft. mulga scrub in all directions.
MARKINGS: White circle and wind indicator.
DIMENSIONS: N-S, 880 yards; E-W, 860 yards.
SURFACE: Generally good. Red gravelly loam.
