


LICENSED AERODROME, "B" CLASS



LATITUDE: 34° 34' S; LONGITUDE: 146° 24½ E; MAG. VAR: 7½ E app.  
 ALTITUDE: 460 feet approx.  
 POSITION: Half mile S of Leeton on E side of Junee-Leeton railway.

RELEVANT AVIATION MAPS: Mercator Sheet K.8. Stripmap 9.  
 SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Generally lightly timbered with some open spaces suitable for forced landings.

LANDMARKS: Railway line alongside on W. Lake near southern boundary.

APPROACHES: N - sheds and few trees. S - fence 7 ft. high.  
 E - scattered trees. W - electric wires 15 ft. high along road. Telephone line 18 ft. high along railway.

MARKINGS: White circle and wind indicator.

DIMENSIONS: NNE-SSW, 700 yds. WNW-ESE, 660 yds.

SURFACE: Good hard surface.

TOWN & RAILWAY STATION: Leeton, ½ mile N.

TELEPHONE: House 300 yds. NE (Mrs. McEachern, Leeton 219).

HANGARS: Nil.

REPAIRS & REFUELLING: Leeton.

WATER: On aerodrome.

PROPRIETORS: Willimbong Shire Council, Box 94, Leeton, N.S.W.

CHARGES: 1-2 seater - 2/6 per landing, 10/- per day.
