

LICENSED AERODROME, "C" CLASS



LATITUDE: $21^{\circ} 06\frac{1}{2}'$ S; LONGITUDE: $116^{\circ} 02\frac{1}{2}'$ E; MAG. VAR: 1° W app.

ALTITUDE: 50 feet approx.

POSITION: About 7 miles NE of Mardie Homestead, and about $\frac{1}{2}$ mile W of tel. line.

RELEVANT AVIATION MAPS: Mercator Sheet F.3. Stripmap No.54.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Scattered scrub.

LANDMARKS: Tel. line $\frac{1}{2}$ mile east.

APPROACHES: Open all around for about 10 chains, thin low scrub. Trees to 20 feet about $\frac{1}{4}$ mile to south.

MARKINGS: White circle, wind indicator and boundary marks.

DIMENSIONS: NW-SE, 660 yards. NNW-SSE, 660 yards.

SURFACE: Good.

TOWN & SEAPORT: Roebourne to N. Onslow to S (both about 92 miles by road).

TELEPHONE: Mardie Homestead.

HANGARS: Nil.

REPAIRS: Melbourne.

REFUELLING: Mardie Homestead, 7 miles SW.

WATER: Windmill, about $\frac{1}{2}$ mile E.

PROPRIETORS: Messrs B.H. Sharpe & Co., Mardie Station.

CHARGES: Nil at present.
