

CLASS OF GROUND: Emergency Landing Ground.
PROPRIETORS: Commonwealth of Australia (Controller of Civil Aviation, Melbourne).
POSITION: Lat. $18^{\circ}38'S$. Long. $126^{\circ}53'E$. About $1\frac{1}{2}$ miles E.N.E. of homestead.
MAGNETIC VARIATION: About $2\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}E$.
DISTINCTIVE FEATURES: Clearing in spinifex, area bounded in North by low hills.
MARKINGS: White cross and wind indicator.
DESCRIPTION: Level surface, ironstone gravel. Suitable all weather.
DIMENSIONS: N. - S. 480 yards.
E. - W. 590 yards.
HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: About 650 feet.
APPROACHES: North, over low ridge; East and West, clear; South, over low fence.
SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Open plain; black soil, spinifex and ant bed.
PETROL AND OIL: At homestead.
WATER SUPPLY: At homestead.
WORKSHOPS: Blacksmiths' tools at Louisa Downs, 15 miles South.
HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.
TELEGRAPH: Hall's Creek Post Office, 85 miles East.
NEAREST TOWN: Derby, 315 miles West.
REMARKS: Relative Strip Map No. 56.
