


## NOTICE TO AIRMEN

MARIMO, QLD.

**CLASS OF GROUND:** Emergency Landing Ground.  
**PROPRIETORS:** Commonwealth of Australia, (Controller of Civil Aviation, Melbourne).  
**POSITION:** 12 miles South West of Cloncurry,  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile West of Cloncurry-Duchess railway. Lat.  $20^{\circ} 49'S$ . Long.  $140^{\circ} 24'E$ .  
**MAGNETIC VARIATION:**  $5\frac{1}{2}$  E. approx.  
**DISTINCTIVE FEATURES:** Road and Tel. line on Western side. Railway about  $\frac{3}{4}$  mile to the East.  
**MARKINGS:** White Cross and Wind Indicator.  
**DESCRIPTION:** "L" shaped ground, fair surface.  
**DIMENSIONS:** N. - S. 540 yards.  
 E. - W. 450 yards.  
**HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL:** 750 ft. approx.  
**APPROACHES:** Over fallen timber.  
**SURROUNDING COUNTRY:** Ridgy and timbered; unsuitable for forced landings.  
**PETROL AND OIL:** Cloncurry, 13 miles N.E. by road.  
**WATER SUPPLY:** At Marimo Rly. Siding,  $\frac{3}{4}$  mile East.  
**WORKSHOPS:** Cloncurry.  
**HANGAR ACCOMMODATION:** Nil.  
**NEAREST TELEPHONE:** Cloncurry, 13 miles N.E. by road.  
**NEAREST TELEGRAPH:** Cloncurry, 13 miles N.E. by road.  
**NEAREST TOWN:** Cloncurry, 13 miles N.E. by road.  
**NEAREST RAILWAY STATION:** Marimo siding about  $\frac{3}{4}$  mile East.
