


MASCOT, N.S.W.



CLASS OF GROUND: Aerodrome suitable for all types of landplanes.
PROPRIETORS: Civil Aviation Board, Melbourne.

POSITION: On the left bank of Cook's River, near its entrance to Botany Bay. Lat. 33° 57' S. Long. 151° 11' E.

MAGNETIC VARIATION: About 9 1/2° E.

LANDMARKS: Cook's River and Botany Bay immediately south; junction of Shea's Creek and Cook's River to north-west; railway line to north; Ascot racecourse 1/2 mile to the east.

MARKINGS: Wind indicators (2) one illuminated.

SURFACE ETC.: Good level surface, with one runway.

DIMENSIONS: N.E.-S.W. 1,100 yards. N.W.-S.E. 900 yards; runway N.W.-S.E. 500 yards by 25 yards wide.

HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: About 10 feet.

APPROACHES: North - railway with telephone line (25 feet). East - hangars etc., otherwise clear.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Suburbs of Sydney, mostly unsuitable for forced landing.

PETROL, OIL AND WORKSHOPS: On aerodrome.

HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Several hangars, up to 100 feet span.

TELEPHONE & TELEGRAPH: Numerous telephones available; Officer-in-charge - Mascot 536.

NEAREST TOWN: Mascot, suburb of Sydney.

RAILWAY STATION: Tempe 1 1/2 miles west; tram to Sydney about 1 mile east; good taxi service.

CHARGES: Nil at present.

REMARKS: Hangar and other building sites may be leased from the Civil Aviation Board. Aerodrome is under control of the District Superintendent. (Office - phone Mascot 536.) Stripmaps Nos. 2, 10, 12, 43 and 52.
