IT is hereby notified that an Aerodrome has been established at  
MAYLANDS, PERTH, WESTERN AUSTRALIA.

The following particulars regarding this Aerodrome are published for information:—

<i>Proprietors</i> .. ..	Commonwealth of Australia. (Controller of Civil Aviation, Melbourne.)
<i>Class of Aerodrome</i> ..	All types of landplanes.
<i>Position</i> .. ..	Latitude, 31° 57' S.; longitude, 115° 54' E. Situating on north side of Swan River, in a pronounced horse-shoe bend, 2½ miles east of the City of Perth.
<i>Distinctive Features</i> ..	Burswood Island, on which are two race-courses, and Railway Bridge to west.
<i>Markings</i> .. ..	No ground mark has been laid. Wind indicator on hangar.
<i>Description</i> .. ..	Surface fair. Inclined to be boggy in parts after heavy rain.
<i>Dimensions for Landing</i>	<sup>750</sup> 660 yards north and south. <i>N.T.A. 1/36</i> <sup>1200</sup> 800 yards east and west.
<i>Height above Sea Level</i>	About 6 feet.
<i>Magnetic Variation</i> ..	4° 45' W. (approximately).
<i>Approaches</i> .. ..	North, open. South, across river, then rising ground. East, generally open. West, over river and Burswood Island.
<i>Surrounding Country</i> ..	Generally unsuitable for forced landings.
<i>Petrol and Oil</i> .. ..	At aerodrome.
<i>Water Supply</i> .. ..	At hangars.
<i>Workshops</i> .. ..	At aerodrome.
<i>Hangar Accommodation</i>	One hangar, 78 feet x 90 feet (West Australia Airways Limited). One hangar, 90 feet x 120 feet (West Australia Airways Limited). One hangar, 40 feet x 30 feet (Air Transport Limited).
<i>Nearest Telephone &amp; No.</i>	Caretaker's residence, adjoining the aerodrome—A. 1841. Telephone also on aerodrome.
<i>Nearest Telegraph</i> ..	Maylands Post Office.
<i>Nearest Town</i> .. ..	Maylands, 1½ miles.
<i>Nearest Railway Station</i>	Maylands, 1½ miles.
<i>Charges</i> .. ..	No landing fees are at present enforced.
<i>Remarks</i> .. ..	A caretaker, in charge of the aerodrome, resides nearby.
