




CLASS OF GROUND: Aerodrome, licensed for all types of landplanes.

PROPRIETORS: City Council of Mildura. (Tel. Mildura 375).

POSITION: $1\frac{1}{2}$ miles W.N.W. of Mildura P.O. at South corner of Eleventh Street and Flora Ave. Lat: $34^{\circ} 11'$ S. Long: $142^{\circ} 11'$ E.

MAGNETIC VARIATION: 7° E. approx.

LANDMARKS: Murray River, about $\frac{1}{2}$ mile to North and West; golf links immediately South; road junction at Northern corner of ground.

MARKINGS: White circle and wind indicator.

SURFACE, Etc.: Graded, red sandy surface.

DIMENSIONS: N.W. - S.E. 770 yards. N.E. - S.W. 660 yards.

HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 170 ft. approx.

APPROACHES: North - Tel. lines to 22 feet and W/T. masts 35 ft. high. North-west - Tel. line 18 ft. high. South-west over trees. East over Tel. line 22 ft. and house on rise. Other directions open.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Vineyards, unsuitable for forced landing.

PETROL AND OIL: Mildura, $1\frac{1}{2}$ miles East.

WATER SUPPLY: House immediately West.

WORKSHOPS: Mildura.

HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: For light aeroplane (folded), key at house immediately West.

TELEPHONE: Hangar (Mildura 467).

TELEGRAPH: Mildura P.O., $1\frac{1}{2}$ miles E.S.E.

NEAREST TOWN: Mildura, $1\frac{1}{2}$ miles E.

RAILWAY STATION: Mildura, about 2 miles E.

CHARGES: 2s. 6d. for each landing, £1.0.0 per day.

REMARKS: The actual boundaries are liable to change owing to sand being blown across the aerodrome.
