




LICENSED AERODROME, "C" CLASS



LATITUDE:  $18^{\circ} 14\frac{1}{2}'$  S; LONGITUDE:  $140^{\circ} 55'$  E; MAG. VAR:  $5^{\circ}$  E app.  
ALTITUDE: 100 feet approx.

POSITION: Immediately NE of Milgarra Station homestead,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  miles east of the Flinders River and about 45 SSW of Normanton.

RELEVANT AVIATION MAPS: Mercator Sheet E.7. Stripmap No.29.  
SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Flat with occasional rough-surfaced clear patches. Timbered, black soil.

LANDMARKS: Milgarra Station homestead 200 yards SW. Ground of irregular shape in low timber.

APPROACHES: N and NE - clear. Other approaches over 20' timber.  
MARKINGS: White circle and wind indicator. Tops of fence posts painted white.

DIMENSIONS: N-S, 770 yds. E-W, 550 yds.

SURFACE: Gravel surface, suitable in all weather.

TOWN & RAILWAY STATION: Normanton, 45 miles.

TELEPHONE: At homestead.

HANGARS: Nil.

REPAIRS: At homestead.

REFUELLING: Limited supplies at homestead - large supplies at Normanton.

WATER: At homestead.

PROPRIETOR: Mr. T.L. Boileau, Milgarra Station, via Normanton, Qld.

CHARGES: Nil at present.

SPECIAL REMARKS: Extreme caution is to be exercised in the use of this ground after rain.
