

LICENSED AERODROME, "C" CLASS



**LATITUDE:** 23° 52' S; **LONGITUDE:** 113° 58' E; **MAG. VAR.:** 2½° W. app.  
**ALTITUDE:** 100 feet approx.  
**POSITION:** Situated about 1½ miles south of Minilya Homestead and ½ mile west of Minilya Pool.  
**RELEVANT AVIATION MAPS:** Mercator Sheet G.3. Stripmap No. 54.  
**SURROUNDING COUNTRY:** Scrubby, with some open country (claypans, etc.). Fair for forced landings.  
**LANDMARKS:** Tel. line 2 miles west; Minilya Homestead and Minilya River to north; pool with timber on east side.  
**APPROACHES:** Fairly clear in all directions.  
**MARKINGS:** White circle and wind indicator; plough furrow around boundary with white tins as corner marks.  
**DIMENSIONS:** N-S, 680 yards. E-W, 700 yards.  
**SURFACE:** Good.

**TOWN:** Carnarvon about 80 miles (by air) SW.  
**TELEPHONE:** At homestead.  
**HANGARS:** Nil.  
**REPAIRS & REFUELLING:** At homestead.  
**WATER:** At homestead.

**PROPRIETORS:** Minilya Pastoral Company Ltd. (W.M. Lyall, General Manager).
