



## NOTICE TO AIRMEN

NO.80/1937.

WIRELESS MASTS AT DUNDAS &amp; PENNANT HILLS, NSW.



High wireless masts have been erected at the positions as shown on the sketches above.

DUNDAS BROADCASTING STATION, 2 CH.

Lat:  $33^{\circ} 48' 06''$  S. Long:  $151^{\circ} 03' 36''$  E.

Approx.  $11\frac{1}{2}$  miles north west of Mascot Aerodrome.

Stripmaps Nos. 2, 4, 10, 12, 43 and 52.

The masts (2) are 310 feet high. Ground level at base is approx. 225 feet.

Throughout the night a white light is displayed at each mast head and is visible from 7 - 10 miles under normal conditions.

PENNANT HILLS BROADCASTING STATIONS, 2 FC AND 2 SM.

Lat:  $33^{\circ} 46' 00''$  S.; Long:  $151^{\circ} 03' 09''$  E.

Approx. 14 miles north west of Mascot Aerodrome.

Stripmaps Nos. 2, 4, 10, 12, 43 and 52.

The masts (several) range in heights up to 450 feet. Ground level at base is approx. 350 feet.

The masts are fitted with regulation lights which are displayed from sunset to sunrise.
