


ST. GEORGE, QLD.

(FIRST ISSUE - SEPTEMBER 1940) LICENSED AERODROME - "A" CLASS



LATITUDE: 28° 03' S; LONGITUDE: 148° 35½' E; MAG. VAR: 8° E. app.

ALTITUDE: 650 feet approx.

POSITION: One mile east of St. George Township.

RELEVANT AVIATION MAP: Mercator Sheet H.9.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Generally timbered - unsuitable for forced landings.

LANDMARKS: Town of St. George and Balonne River 1 mile west.
House adjacent to E boundary.

APPROACHES: Over stumps - timber cut back 10 chains on all sides.

MARKINGS: Wind indicator, white circle and boundary mark - posts on N and W painted white (see sketch).

DIMENSIONS: NE-SW, 1,200 yds. NW-SE, 1,100 yds.

SURFACE: Generally firm even surface, but inclined to be heavy where sand ridges have been levelled.

TOWN: St. George, 1 mile west.

RAILWAY STATION: Thallon about 50 miles SSE.

TELEPHONE: St. George.

HANGAR: One.

REPAIRS & REFUELLING: St. George.

WATER: St. George.

CHARGES: Nil at present.
