


CLASS OF GROUND: Emergency Landing Ground.
PROPRIETORS: Commonwealth of Australia, (Controller of Civil Aviation, Melbourne).
POSITION: Situated about 1 mile North East of Summervale Siding.
 Lat. $31^{\circ}25'S$. Long. $147^{\circ}3'E$.
MAGNETIC VARIATION: $7\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}E$. approx.
DISTINCTIVE FEATURES: Clearing in timber on N.E. side of Bourke-Nyngan Railway.
MARKINGS: White Cross and Wind Indicator.
DESCRIPTION: Level surface - previously cultivated; should be suitable in all weather.
DIMENSIONS: N. - S. 900 yards.
 E. - W. 630 yards.
HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 550 ft. approx.
APPROACHES: N. : Gaps in timber.
 E. : Timber to 40 ft. high.
 S.E. : Cleared approach.
 S. & W. : Timber to 20 ft. high.
SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Generally flat, but heavily timbered.
PETROL AND OIL: Nyngan, 12 miles S.E.
WATER SUPPLY: At house adjacent.
WORKSHOPS: Nyngan, 12 miles S.E.
HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.
NEAREST TELEPHONE: Nyngan, 12 miles S.E.
NEAREST TELEGRAPH: Nyngan, 12 miles S.E.
NEAREST TOWN: Nyngan, 12 miles S.E.
