



NOTICE TO AIRMEN

CLASS OF GROUND: Aerodrome licensed for single engined landplanes only.

PROPRIETORS: Messrs. Wilson and Dushatel.

POSITION: North of junction of Snake River and Watut River.

Approx. 30 miles west of Salamaua. Lat. $7^{\circ} 2\frac{1}{2}' S$. Long. $146^{\circ} 36' E$.

MAGNETIC VARIATION: $5\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} E$. approx.

LANDMARKS: To S.E. line of abrupt grass hills, (1500 ft.) $\frac{3}{4}$ -mile distant. To north, timbered range (2000 ft.) $\frac{1}{2}$ mile distant. West, Watut Valley. South, over Watut River, and mountains.

MARKINGS: Nil.

SURFACE: Single runway running $N. 35^{\circ} W$. ($S. 35^{\circ} E$). Landings to be made from the south only.

DIMENSIONS: N.W.-S.E. 425 yards, by 70 yards wide.

HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 1700 ft. approx.

APPROACHES: From the south only - clear.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Mountainous.

PETROL AND OIL: Bulwa, 4 hours walk south along Watut valley. Four minutes by air.

WATER SUPPLY: At aerodrome.

WORKSHOPS: At Lae and Bulwa.

HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.

TELEPHONE & TELEGRAPH: Bulwa.

NEAREST TOWN: Wau. 25 miles S.E. by S.

NEAREST PORT: Salamaua, 30 miles East.

CHARGES: Nil.

REMARKS: European conducting store at aerodrome. Sleeping accommodation and food may be obtained. The ground is suitable for landing in all weathers.
