

SWANSEA, TAS.



CLASS OF GROUND: Aerodrome licensed for all single-engined landplanes.

PROPRIETOR: E. B. Shaw, Esq., Red Bank, Swansea, Tasmania.

POSITION: About $\frac{1}{2}$ mile N.W. from Swansea Post Office.

Lat. $42^{\circ} 08'S$. Long. $148^{\circ} 02'E$.

MAGNETIC VARIATION: $-8\frac{1}{2}$ E. approx.

DISTINCTIVE FEATURES: Aerodrome lies about one mile from the shore of Oyster Bay, between Swansea township and the Meredith River. Swansea township on south boundary;

Meredith River to the north; Waterloo Point to the east.

MARKINGS: White Circle and Wind Indicator.

DESCRIPTION: L shaped ground with good surface; soft in wet weather.

DIMENSIONS: N. - S 720 yards

WNW. - ESE. 700 yards

N.E. - S.W. 630 yards.

HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 30 ft. approx.

APPROACHES: N.E. - Trees 25 ft. high along boundary fence.

S.W. - Light timber 20 ft. high.

S.E. - Stumps along road.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Timbered undulating and hilly country to S. and S.E.; some open paddocks to the N.; town to the S.

PETROL AND OIL: Swansea.

WATER SUPPLY: Swansea.

WORKSHOPS: Swansea.

HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.

TELEPHONE & TELEGRAPH: Swansea.

NEAREST TOWN: Swansea.

NEAREST RAILWAY STATION: St. Mary's, 40 miles N. by road.

(Ship calls at Swansea.)
