


CLASS OF GROUND: Aerodrome licensed for all single and light multi-engined aircraft.

PROPRIETORS: The Inglewood Shire Council, P.O. box 11, Inglewood.

POSITION: About one mile N.W. of town of Texas.

Lat.  $28^{\circ} 51' S.$  Long.  $151^{\circ} 09' E.$

MAGNETIC VARIATION:  $8\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} E.$  approx.

LANDMARKS: Creeks on south, west and N.W. and road on north to S.E. boundaries.

MARKINGS: White circle, wind indicator and boundary marks.

SURFACE: Fairly even grassy surface.

DIMENSIONS: W.N.W. - E.S.E. 880 yards.

N.W. - S.E. 750 "

N.E. - S.W. 680 "

HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 1160 ft. approx.

APPROACHES: West, N.W. and south, fallen timber; N.E. and east, telephone line.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Timbered, with some open fields.

PETROL AND OIL: Texas, 1 mile S.E.

WATER SUPPLY: At creek alongside.

WORKSHOPS: Texas.

HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.

TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH: Texas.

NEAREST TOWN AND RAILWAY STATION: Texas.
