



NOTICE TO AIRMEN

CLASS OF GROUND: Emergency landing ground.

PROPRIETORS: Civil Aviation Board, Melbourne.

POSITION: 26 miles west of Balranald, about 3 miles south of Balranald - Euston road, on N. bank of Peacock Ck.

Lat: $34^{\circ} 36'$ S. Long: $143^{\circ} 07'$ E.MAGNETIC VARIATION: 7° E. approx.

LANDMARKS: Abbott's Tank on Euston - Balranald road, 3 miles to north. (See plan above).

MARKINGS: White cross, wind indicator, and boundary marks on N. W. boundary.

SURFACE: Good surface, grass covered.

DIMENSIONS: N. - S. 570 yards, NW. - SE. 570 yards.

HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 205 ft. approx.

APPROACHES: Over dense mallee scrub to 35 ft. high in all directions.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Timber and mallee scrub.

PETROL, OIL & WORKSHOPS: Balranald, 26 miles east.

WATER SUPPLY: Creek nearby.

HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.

TELEPHONE: At Homestead, $4\frac{1}{2}$ miles south-west.

TELEGRAPH: Balranald P.O. 26 miles east.

NEAREST TOWN & RAILWAY STATION: Balranald.

CHARGES: Nil.
