


TILPA, N.S.W.



CLASS OF GROUND: Emergency landing ground.  
PROPRIETORS: Commonwealth of Australia (Controller of Civil Aviation, Melbourne).  
POSITION:  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile N.W. from Tilpa Point, on River Darling.  
Lat.  $30^{\circ}55'$  S. Long.  $144^{\circ}25'$  E.  
MAGNETIC VARIATION:  $7^{\circ}$  E. approx.  
LANDMARKS: Darling River to the southeast; township of Tilpa to the southwest; Sand ridge to the northeast; range of hills 4 miles to the northwest.  
MARKINGS: White cross, wind indicator and boundary marks.  
SURFACE: Level surface of black soil.  
DIMENSIONS: 660 yards square.  
HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 300 ft. approx.  
APPROACHES: North, south and west - open; east - telegraph line.  
SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Scattered timber with open spaces.  
PETROL AND OIL: Tilpa.  
WATER SUPPLY: Tilpa.  
WORKSHOPS: Bourke, 120 miles north east.  
HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.  
TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH: Tilpa.  
NEAREST TOWN: Tilpa.  
NEAREST RAILWAY STATION: Bourke.  
REMARKS: Blacksoil surface suitable for use in dry weather only.
