




GOVERNMENT AERODROME, "B" CLASS



LATITUDE: 27° 32' S. LONGITUDE: 151° 55' E. MAG. VAR: 8½° E. app.
ALTITUDE: 1900 feet approx.

POSITION: On south side of main Dalby road, about 2¼ miles west of Toowoomba.

RELEVANT AVIATION MAPS: Mercator sheet H.9. Stripmaps Nos. 3, 49 and 61.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Generally suitable for forced landings.

LANDMARKS: Old racecourse to SE.

APPROACHES: North - houses, trees and windmill to 30 ft. high.
NE - telephone and E.S. line 30 ft. high. Other directions clear.

MARKINGS: White circle, 2 wind indicators and tins painted white on fence posts.

DIMENSIONS: N-S, 880 yards. E-W, 870 yards.

SURFACE: Undulating, fair.

TOWN & RAILWAY STATION: Toowoomba, 2¼ miles east.

TELEPHONE: At nearby house.

HANGARS: Nil.

REPAIRS: Toowoomba.

REFUELLING: At aerodrome.

WATER: Well in NE corner of ground.

PROPRIETORS: Department of Civil Aviation, Melbourne.

CHARGES: Nil.
