




LATITUDE: 32° 54' S; LONGITUDE: 141° 59' E; MAG. VAR: 7° E app.

ALTITUDE: 200 feet approx.

POSITION: 65 miles SW of Menindee; 7 miles NW of homestead.

RELEVANT AVIATION MAPS: Mercator Sheet J.7.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Timbered, few small open spaces.

LANDMARKS: White cottage, $\frac{3}{4}$ mile S. Homestead about 7 miles SE.

APPROACHES: North - over sand ridge and 25 ft. trees; East - over 30 ft. trees; South and west - clear.

MARKINGS: White circle and wind indicator. White posts at corners of landing area.

DIMENSIONS: NW-SE, 770 yards. WSW-ENE, 770 yards.

SURFACE: Fair.

TOWN & RAILWAY STATION: Menindee, 65 miles NE.

TELEPHONE: At cottage, $\frac{3}{4}$ mile S.

HANGARS: Nil.

REPAIRS: Broken Hill.

REFUELLING: Limited supply at homestead.

WATER: At cottage.

PROPRIETORS: Geo. T. Parker & Sons, Tor Downs Station, via Menindee, N.S.W.

CHARGE: Nil at present.
