


**TOWNSVILLE, QLD.**



**CLASS OF GROUND:** Aerodrome licensed for all types of landplanes.  
**PROPRIETORS:** Townsville City Council, Townsville, Queensland.  
**POSITION:**  $3\frac{1}{2}$  miles south of the City of Townsville on the right bank of Ross River. Lat:  $19^{\circ} 19' S$ ; Long:  $146^{\circ} 48\frac{1}{2}' E$ .  
**MAGNETIC VARIATION:**  $6^{\circ} E$ . approx.  
**LANDMARKS:** Road bridge over Ross River; and Meat Works.  
**MARKINGS:** White circle and wind indicator. Tops of pole lines to north are painted yellow.  
**SURFACE:** Good, hard surface; suitable for use in all weather.  
**DIMENSIONS:** North-south 810 yards; East-west 680 yards.  
**HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL:** 12 feet approx.  
**APPROACHES:** North - telephone and power lines 20 feet high.  
 South - few trees and scrub along creek.  
 East and west - few trees.  
**SURROUNDING COUNTRY:** North - scattered houses. South - mountainous. East - few trees and scrub. West - few trees.  
**PETROL, OIL & WATER SUPPLY:** On aerodrome.  
**WORKSHOPS:** Townsville.  
**HANGAR ACCOMMODATION:** Hangar 101 ft. x 65 ft.  
**TELEPHONE & TELEGRAPH:** At Hangar (Townsville 968) or in town.  
**NEAREST TOWN & RAILWAY STATION:** Townsville,  $3\frac{1}{2}$  miles.  
**CHARGES:** 1-2 seater,  $2/6$  per landing - 10/- per day.  
 3-4 " 5/- " " - 15/- " "  
 5-6 " 7/6 " " " - 25/- " "  
 Over 6 " 10/- " " " - 40/- " "  
**REMARKS:** Pilots should beware of radio mast 250 ft. high, near mouth of Ross River (see sketch).  
 Stripmaps Nos. 62, 63 and 66.
