


EMERGENCY LANDING GROUND



LATITUDE: $17^{\circ} 49' S$; LONGITUDE: $128^{\circ} 20' E$; MAG. VAR: $3^{\circ} E$.

ALTITUDE: About 800 feet.

POSITION: 50 miles NE of Halls Creek, about 8 miles south of the Ord River and north of Hardman Range. About 3 miles east of Homestead.

RELEVANT AVIATION MAP: Mercator Sheet E.5. Stripmap No.56

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Generally open, and suitable for forced landings.

LANDMARKS: Hardman Ranges and Pantor River (see sketch).

APPROACHES: Clear in all directions.

MARKINGS: White cross and wind indicator.

DIMENSIONS: N-S, 500 yds; E-W, 770 yds.

SURFACE: Good. Level sandy red loam.

TOWN & SEAPORT: Wyndham, about 250 miles by road.

TELEPHONE: At Homestead.

HANGARS: Nil.

REPAIRS: Blacksmith's tools at Homestead.

REFUELLING: At Homestead 3 miles west.

WATER: At Homestead.

PROPRIETORS: Civil Aviation Department.

CHARGES: Nil.
