


## NOTICE TO AIRMEN

NO. 21/1931

WAGIN, W.A.



**CLASS OF GROUND:** Aerodrome licensed for use by all types of landplanes.

**PROPRIETORS:** Wagin Municipal Council, Wagin, W.A.

**POSITION:** Racecourse  $\frac{1}{4}$  mile East of Wagin Town.  
Latitude S.  $33^{\circ} 20'$ ; longitude E.  $117^{\circ} 25'$ .

**DISTINCTIVE FEATURES:** Race Track and Grand Stand. Wagin-Dumblaying Railway along North-West boundary. Large lakes about 1 mile South.

**MARKINGS:** Wind Indicator and white circle.

**DESCRIPTION:** Oval ground mostly inside race track, with extension to fence on Western side. Level sandy loam well grassed. Would probably be heavy in a wet winter.

**DIMENSIONS:** North-South 700 yards; East-West 570 yards.

**HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL:** 840 feet (approx.)

**MAGNETIC VARIATION:**  $5^{\circ} 8'$  W. (approx.)

**APPROACHES:** North-West - Railway. Telephone line 18 feet, timber to 30 ft. high, and felled approaches.  
South - Timber to 30 ft. high and felled approaches.  
East - Felled approaches and low scrub.  
West - Felled approaches and small open paddocks.

**SURROUNDING COUNTRY:** Few open patches, but mostly timbered.

**PETROL AND OIL:** Wagin,  $\frac{1}{4}$  mile North-West.

**WATER SUPPLY:** Dam on Western side.

**WORKSHOPS:** Wagin.

**NEAREST TELEPHONE:** Wagin,  $\frac{1}{4}$  mile.

**NEAREST TELEGRAPH:** Wagin.

**NEAREST TOWN:** Wagin.

**NEAREST RAILWAY STATION:** Wagin.

**CHARGES:** Under consideration.

**REMARKS:** This ground is liable to be used for grazing stock. The proprietors should be advised by pilots before visiting Wagin.
