



NOTICE TO AIRMEN

CLASS OF GROUND: Single strip suitable for single and light twin engined landplanes up to a total load of 4,500 lbs.

PROPRIETORS: Oil Search Limited, Wewak, New Guinea.

POSITION: From Wewak 86 miles 257° magnetic.

From Aitape 43 miles 171° magnetic.

Lat: 3° 47' S; Long: 142° 26' E.

MAGNETIC VARIATION: 4½° E. approx.

LANDMARKS: Located in timbered ridges west of the Namblo River.

Edge of Sepik River plains approx. 12 miles south.

MARKINGS: Nil.

SURFACE: Single strip, falling approx. 1 in 11 to the west; hard in all weathers.

DIMENSIONS: E.-W. approx., single strip 360 yards by 33 yards.

HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 500 feet.

APPROACHES: Approach from the west only, over timbered ridges.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Heavily timbered ridges up to 1,400 feet; unsuitable for forced landings.

PETROL, OIL & WORKSHOPS: Nil.

WATER SUPPLY: Oil Search Limited's base camp adjacent.

HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.

TELEPHONE & TELEGRAPH: Radio Station at Mai Mai.

NEAREST TOWN: Wewak 86 miles. Maprik mining centre directly on route from Wewak.

CHARGES: Nil at present.

REMARKS: A smudge fire is lighted on the approach of any aircraft. Care should be exercised when taking off if the wind is down the slope.
