


WARWICK, QLD.

(REVISED - SEPTEMBER, 1940.)

LICENSED AERODROME, "C" CLASS



LATITUDE:  $28^{\circ} 15\frac{1}{2}'$  S. LONGITUDE:  $152^{\circ} 02\frac{1}{2}'$  E. MAG. VAR:  $9^{\circ}$  E. app.

ALTITUDE: 1500 feet approx.

POSITION: Approximately 3 miles SSE of Warwick.

RELEVANT AVIATION MAPS: Mercator sheet H.9. Stripmap No.49.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Timbered, with open spaces suitable for forced landings.

LANDMARKS: Town of Warwick 3 miles NNW. Railway  $1\frac{1}{4}$  miles west and creeks along N and E boundaries.

APPROACHES: 60 ft. timber about 10 chains back in all directions.

MARKINGS: White circle and wind indicator. Logs, painted white, every two chains around boundary.

DIMENSIONS: N-S, 680 yards. E-W, 630 yards.

SURFACE: Fair.

TOWN & RAILWAY STATION: Warwick, 3 miles NNW.

TELEPHONE: Warwick.

HANGARS: Nil.

REPAIRS & REFUELLING: Warwick.

WATER: At Sanitary Depot,  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile north.

PROPRIETORS: Warwick Town Council, Warwick, Queensland.

CHARGES: Single landings  $\frac{2}{6}$  per plane.

SPECIAL REMARKS: Under certain wind conditions it may be necessary to restrict aircraft loading.
