



NOTICE TO AIRMEN

(POLICE STATION) WAVE HILL, N.T.



CLASS OF GROUND: Aerodrome suitable for use by all types of landplanes.

PROPRIETORS: Commonwealth of Australia (Controller of Civil Aviation, Melbourne).

POSITION: On West side of Victoria River, 9 miles West of Wave Hill Homestead. Lat. $17^{\circ} 28' S.$, Long. $130^{\circ} 50' E.$

DISTINCTIVE FEATURES: Fence along Western boundary; Victoria River to East.

MARKINGS: White Circle and Wind Indicator.

DESCRIPTION: Irregular shape, level, light red clayey soil. Should be suitable in all weathers. Marked re-entrant with washout on Southern boundary.

DIMENSIONS: N.-S. 700 yards; E.-W. 660 yards.

HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 700 feet approx.

MAGNETIC VARIATION: $3\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} E.$ approx.

APPROACHES: Open all round. Fence along Western side.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Undulating and stony; some open patches suitable for landing.

PETROL AND OIL: Wave Hill Homestead, 10 miles East.

WATER SUPPLY: Police Station, adjacent.

WORKSHOPS: Wave Hill Garage.

HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.

NEAREST TELEGRAPH: Wireless at Wave Hill Homestead.

NEAREST TOWN: Katherine, 310 miles North-North-East.

NEAREST RAILWAY STATION: Katherine.

RELATIVE STRIP MAP: No. 1.
