




**CLASS OF GROUND:** Aerodrome licensed for light types of land planes, such as D.H. "Moth", Avro "Avian", etc.  
**PROPRIETORS:** Aerial Commerce Company, Mr. H.C. Ittershagen, 5 Smythe Road, West Subiaco, W.A. R.S. 5 miles  
**POSITION:** 1¼ miles north-west of West Subiaco R.S. 5 miles W. of Perth. Lat: 31° 57' S. Long: 115° 47' E.  
**MAGNETIC VARIATION:** 4½° West approx.  
**LANDMARKS:** Aerodrome appears as a clearing in timber.  
**MARKINGS:** White semi-circle and wind indicator.  
**SURFACE:** Sandy soil, surface undulating. Should be satisfactory in all weathers.  
**DIMENSIONS:** North-South 430 yards; East-West 660 yards.  
**HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL:** 40 ft. approx.  
**APPROACHES:** Over timber in all directions. Trees have been felled to improve approaches.  
**SURROUNDING COUNTRY:** Generally unsuited for forced landings.  
**PETROL & OIL:** Available on aerodrome.  
**WORKSHOPS:** Small workshop at aerodrome, otherwise at owner's place of business at West Subiaco.  
**WATER SUPPLY:** Tank on aerodrome.  
**HANGAR ACCOMMODATION:** Accommodation available for three Moths (folded).  
**TELEPHONE & TELEGRAPH:** At hangar or West Subiaco Post Office.  
**NEAREST TOWN & RAILWAY STATION:** West Subiaco.  
**CHARGES:** No charge at present.  
**REMARKS:** Aerodrome is surrounded by dirt track for motor-cycle racing 30 feet wide. Stripmaps Nos. 18 and 53.
