




**CLASS OF GROUND:** Aerodrome suitable for all types of landplanes.  
**PROPRIETORS:** Wiluna Roads Board, P.O. Box 12, Wiluna, W.A.  
**POSITION:** 3 miles south of Wiluna. 1 mile west of mine main buildings. Lat: 26° 28' S; Long: 120° 13' E.  
**MAGNETIC VARIATION:** ½ West approx.  
**LANDMARKS:** Lake Violet 2 miles east. Wiluna 3 miles north. Mine main buildings 1 mile east.  
**MARKINGS:** White circle, corner marks, and wind indicator.  
**AIRWAY LIGHT:** On headframe of mine, 114 feet above ground, 2,000 yards from aerodrome on bearing 80°. Single beam, 6 R.P.M. visible about 50 miles.  
 Operates daily, sunset to 7.30 p.m. or on request.  
**SURFACE:** Level, probably heavy after rain.  
**DIMENSIONS:** N.W.-S.E. 880 yards; N.E.-S.W. 880 yards.  
**HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL:** 1,600 feet approx.  
**APPROACHES:** N. S. and W. scrub 6 ft. high; E. bushes 1' 6" high.  
**SURROUNDING COUNTRY:** Generally rough, but with suitable spots for forced landings.  
**PETROL & OIL:** Wiluna, 3 miles north.  
**WORKSHOPS:** Mine adjacent.  
**WATER SUPPLY:** Mine adjacent.  
**HANGAR ACCOMMODATION:** One hangar 60 feet by 40 feet.  
**TELEPHONE & TELEGRAPH:** Mine, 1 mile east, or Wiluna P.O.  
**NEAREST TOWN & RAILWAY STATION:** Wiluna.  
**CHARGES:**

1 or 2 seater,	2/6	per landing	or	10/-	per day.
