




LATITUDE: 22° 22' S; LONGITUDE: 143° 02' E; MAG. VAR: 6° E app.  
ALTITUDE: 610 feet approx.

POSITION: About 1½ miles N-W of Winton township.

RELEVANT AVIATION MAPS: Mercator Sheet F.8. Stripmaps Nos. 57 and 58.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Generally open - suitable for forced landings.

LANDMARKS: Day: Township of Winton 1½ miles S-E.  
Night: Airway light situated 1¼ miles S-E on top of wool scour, 6 r.p.m., Elevation 2°, visible 40 miles. Switched on as required; ring Electrical Engineer, Winton.

APPROACHES: Clear in all directions except for small rises as shown in sketch.

MARKINGS: White circle and wind indicator - fenced all round.

DIMENSIONS: NNE-SSW, 1,320 yds. WNW-ESE, 880 yds.

SURFACE: Good level surface - 4 landing strips as shown in sketch.

TOWN & RAILWAY STATION: Winton, 1½ miles S-E.

TELEPHONE: At Wool Scour.

HANGARS: Nil.

REPAIRS & REFUELLING: Winton.

WATER: At Wool Scour.
