


LATITUDE: 28° 21' S; LONGITUDE: 116° 40' E; MAG. VAR: 2° W app.

ALTITUDE: 1,031 feet approx.

POSITION: Adjacent to Yalgoo railway station.

RELEVANT AVIATION MAP: Mercator Sheet H.3.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Flat to undulating.

LANDMARKS: Geraldton-Cue Railway immediately south; Yalgoo town to west, and open drain along NE boundary.

APPROACHES: North and east - over low scrub; South - over railway cottages and tel. line; West - over township and tel. lines.

MARKINGS: White circle, wind indicator and corner marks.

DIMENSIONS: N-S, 660 yards. E-W, 660 yards.

SURFACE: Good.

TOWN & RAILWAY STATION: Yalgoo, adjacent to west.

TELEPHONE: Yalgoo.

HANGARS: Nil.

REPAIRS & REFUELLING: Yalgoo.

WATER: Well, near wind indicator.
