CLASS OF GROUND: Emergency Landing Ground.
PROPRIETORS: Civil Aviation Board, Melbourne.
POSITION: Situated on the north side of Broken Hill - Menindee Rd., 38 miles E.S.E. of Broken Hill.
 Lat: $32^{\circ} 10\frac{1}{2}'$ S. Long: $142^{\circ} 3'$ E.
MAGNETIC VARIATION: $6\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E. approx.
LANDMARKS: Road running east and west, $\frac{1}{4}$ mile south of ground. Homestead 3 miles south. Railway line 4 miles north-east.
MARKINGS: White cross and wind indicator.
SURFACE: Good sandy loam surface.
DIMENSIONS: N.E. - S.W., 510 yards. N.W. - S.E., 480 yards.
HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 300 ft. approx.
APPROACHES: Clump of low trees to west. Otherwise over low scrub.
SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Low scrub and saltbush, with clear patches. Fair for forced landings.
PETROL AND OIL: Broken Hill, 38 miles W.N.W. A little may be obtained at Kar's Homestead, 3 miles south.
WATER SUPPLY: Kar's Homestead.
WORKSHOPS: Broken Hill garages.
HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.
TELEPHONE: Kar's Homestead.
TELEGRAPH: Broken Hill P.O.
NEAREST TOWN: Broken Hill.
RAILWAY STATION: Horse Lake, 4 miles north-east.
REMARKS: Strip maps Nos. 13, 32 and 52.
