


## DATA SHEET FOR LANDING GROUND NO.513

LICENSED AERODROME. "C" CLASS



LATITUDE:  $34^{\circ} 16' S$ ; LONGITUDE:  $148^{\circ} 18\frac{1}{2}' E$ ; MAG. VAR:  $9^{\circ} E$  app.  
 ALTITUDE: 1,500 feet approx.

POSITION: 3 miles N of town of Young, on S side of the Young-Blayney railway line.

RELEVANT AVIATION MAPS: Mercator Sheet J.9. Stripmaps Nos.12a, 60 and 73.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Low hills and cultivation. Suitable for forced landings to S and W.

LANDMARKS: Railway line 300 yards N; McHenry's Creek near N boundary. Ground is on racecourse.

APPROACHES: North - over rising ground, railway and tel. line.  
 South - over rising ground. East and west - open.

MARKINGS: White circle and wind indicator and boundary marks.

DIMENSIONS: N-S, 600 yards. E-W, 570 yards.

SURFACE: Fair.

TOWN & RAILWAY STATION: Young, 3 miles S.

TELEPHONE: Young.

HANGARS: Nil.

REPAIRS & REFUELLING: Young.

WATER: Dam near W boundary.

PROPRIETORS: The Municipality of Young, Box 37, Young, N.S.W.

CHARGES: Nil at present.
