


CLASS OF GROUND: Emergency Landing Ground.  
 PROPRIETORS: Civil Aviation Board, Melbourne.  
 POSITION: Situated about 50 miles East of Broome, and 1 mile South of tel. line. Lat.: 17° 46' S. Long.: 122° 56' E.  
 MAGNETIC VARIATION: 2° East approx.  
 LANDMARKS: Taylor's Lagoon, about 3 miles West. Tel. line about 1 mile to the North.  
 MARKINGS: White cross and wind indicator.  
 SURFACE: Fair, with some anthills.  
 DIMENSIONS: North-South 480 yards; East-West 440 yards.  
 HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 50 feet approx.  
 APPROACHES: South and South-East clear, otherwise over scrub and timber to 30 feet high.  
 SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Scrubby and timbered.  
 PETROL and OIL: Station homestead about 30 miles West.  
 WATER SUPPLY: Yulleroo well, 1/4 mile East.  
 WORKSHOPS: Broome, 50 miles West.  
 HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.  
 TELEGRAPH and TELEPHONE: Tel. line about 1 mile to North may be tapped in emergency.  
 NEAREST TOWN and SEAPORT: Broome.  
 CHARGES: Nil.  
 REMARKS: The South-West portion of the ground (see sketch) is liable to be covered with water in the wet season.  
 Stripmap No. 55.
