



## NOTICE TO AIRMEN

NO. 21/1935.

ZENAG. N.G.



CLASS OF GROUND: Emergency Landing Ground.

PROPRIETORS: Administration, Territory of New Guinea.

POSITION: In "The Gap" at Zenag, on an open slope immediately west of the Marvuk River.

Lat.  $6^{\circ}57'S$ . Long.  $146^{\circ}38'E$ .

MAGNETIC VARIATION:  $5\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}E$ . approx.

DISTINCTIVE FEATURES: Cleared in open "kunai"\*. Deep gully on north side, native material houses on east.

MARKINGS: Nil.

DESCRIPTION: A one-way ground on a slope of about 1 in 15, falling towards the south.

DIMENSIONS: N - S. 330 yards, by 44 yards wide.

HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 3,400 ft. approx.

APPROACHES: Approach only from the south over clear kunai.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Deep gully on north side, sloping clear kunai on other sides, high mountains two miles away on east and west.

PETROL AND OIL: Nil.

WATER SUPPLY: Marvuk River.

WORKSHOPS: Bulwa, 10 miles south (by air).

HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.

TELEPHONE: Bulwa.

TELEGRAPH: Bulwa.

NEAREST TOWN: Wau, 28 miles (by air) S.E. by S.

CHARGES: Nil.

MARKS: From noon till 5 p.m. a wind usually blows from the north - generally at 20 miles an hour or more, easing off towards sunset.

\* Kunai is a tall, tussocky grass.
